INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF ABSTRACTS

The Organizing Committee welcomes the submission of abstracts for oral or poster sessions. An abstract should be submitted in accordance with the instructions below. Final selections will be made by the Scientific Committee.

- Abstracts must be written in English on the form provided for that purpose.
- Abstracts will be photographically reproduced at a reduction rate of 80% for publication in an abstract book. Care should be taken during their preparation to avoid erasures, smudges and errors. Abstracts with text typed beyond the blue framing lines of the form will not be accepted.
- Abstracts should be typed in 12 pitch (12 letters to an inch) or equivalent, using black ink and single spacing.
- In listing authors' names, the given name initials should precede the family name. The name of the author who will give the presentation should be underlined. Institution name(s) and location(s), including city and country, should follow directly after the authors' names.
- If authors are affiliated with different institutions, each author's name should be followed by a superscript number that corresponds to the institution.
- Begin the body on a new line without indentation. The body of the abstract must be organized in the following sequence : Objective(s), Methodology, Results, Discussion and Conclusion(s). Avoid phrases such as " The results will be discussed " .
- Do not leave empty lines between Title, Authors' Names, Affiliation, and Body.
- Abbreviations must be defined when they first appear, and their use should be minimized.
- Tables and graphs are permitted if they fit within the provided space .
- On the Abstract Form, check the topic that most closely describes the subject of the presentation.

Instructions for submission

- Make sure to fill in all requested information on the Abstract Form. Type in block letters the abstract title, authors' name.
- Do not fold the Abstract Form.
- Abstracts sent by fax cannot be accepted.
